6-8	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Confidently express their thoughts and ideas both in an individual presentation and within a group setting</li> <li>Confidently use Standard English in conversations that require it</li> <li>Sustain the role of a character skilfully and make creative use of a range of dramatic techniques to explore a range of complex roles</li> </ul>
6-7	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Show increasing confidence in expressing their thoughts and ideas both in an individual presentation and within a group setting</li> <li>Use Standard English when appropriate</li> <li>Use drama techniques in collaboration with others to explore complex ideas and feelings of a character</li> </ul>
4-5	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Communicate some thoughts and ideas to an audience and within a group setting</li> <li>Use Standard English when the situation requires it</li> <li>Take on the role of a character with success through the use of their facial expressions, gesture and use of vocabulary</li> </ul>
2-3	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Talk about a topic, place or person for a short period of time</li> <li>Use Standard English when they need to</li> <li>Show some awareness of how a character is feeling in some detail through drama activities</li> </ul>
0-1	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Talk in a simple way about a topic, place or person but may need help from their teacher or others in their class to help develop their ideas in more detail</li> <li>Use more interesting words when They are talking and remember to use Standard English sometimes</li> <li>Show a simple understanding of a character through what I say and how I say it during drama activities</li> </ul>
