2-9	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Show confidence in expressing their thoughts and ideas both in an individual presentation and within a group setting.</li> <li>Show a good command of Standard English and am able to adapt language to meet the needs of the situation consistently</li> <li>Able to sustain the role of a character skilfully through gesture, tone of voice, facial expression and intonation when participating in drama activities.</li> </ul>
4-5	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Show increasing confidence in expressing their thoughts and ideas both in an individual presentation and within a group setting.</li> <li>Show a good command of Standard English and am able to adapt language to meet the needs of the situation with some consistency</li> <li>Take on the role of a character with some skill through the use of their facial expressions, gesture and use of vocabulary</li> </ul>
2-3	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Share some of their thoughts feelings and ideas to an audience and within a group setting</li> <li>Use Standard English when I need to</li> <li>Take on the role of a character and show how they are feeling in some detail though drama activities</li> </ul>
0-1	<ul> <li>Students can:</li> <li>Talk about a topic, place or person for a short period of time</li> <li>Use more interesting words when They are talking and remember to use Standard English sometimes</li> <li>Show a simple understanding of a character through what I say and how I say it during drama activities</li> </ul>
