


Positive Steps @16 is an online platform for students to search for and make college applications.



Attendance is crucial in supporting your child to achieve their potential


- 17 missed school days a year = 1 GCSE grade DROP in achievement.
- Equally important is PUNCTUALITY to registrations and to **all** lessons
- Key messages are given in registration
- The start of lessons are hugely important
- Ensure school bags are organised the night before.
