Predicted GCSE Grade

Where appropriate a **Predicted Grade** is given for each subject which is based on teacher assessments. This is an indication of the most likely GCSE grade a student will achieve if they continue to work at their current rate.

The Predicted grades will be a single number ranging from 1 to 9, where 9 is the highest possible grade.
